## College Matriculation Recommendations for Academic Courses

Beyond our graduation requirements, colleges generally recommend a three-year, if not four-year, sequence in each academic area. Some specific examples of what this might look like:

| Discipline | Deerfield <br> Graduation <br> Requirement | College* Requirement $^{\text {E }}$ |

| English | 4 years | 4 years |
| History and Social <br> Science | 2 years (US History +1) | $3-4$ years of social studies (at least 2 <br> years of history plus one additional <br> history or social science or Phil/Rel) |
| Language | Up to level three of one <br> language | Up to level 4 |
| Math | Algebra 1, Geometry, <br> Algebra 2 | 4 years |
| Science | 2 years lab science | 3 years- Bio, Chem, and Physics |
| Arts | 2 terms graded | DA requirement satisfies most <br> colleges, though the University of <br> California system requires a full year <br> of the same art discipline |
