

## Transfer credits

Students who complete a year or more of high school prior to matriculating at Deerfield Academy may be able to transfer course credits. Transfer credit allocation is subject to review of final transcript and, in some cases, course catalog and descriptions from previous school. Potential eligible courses are included below.
