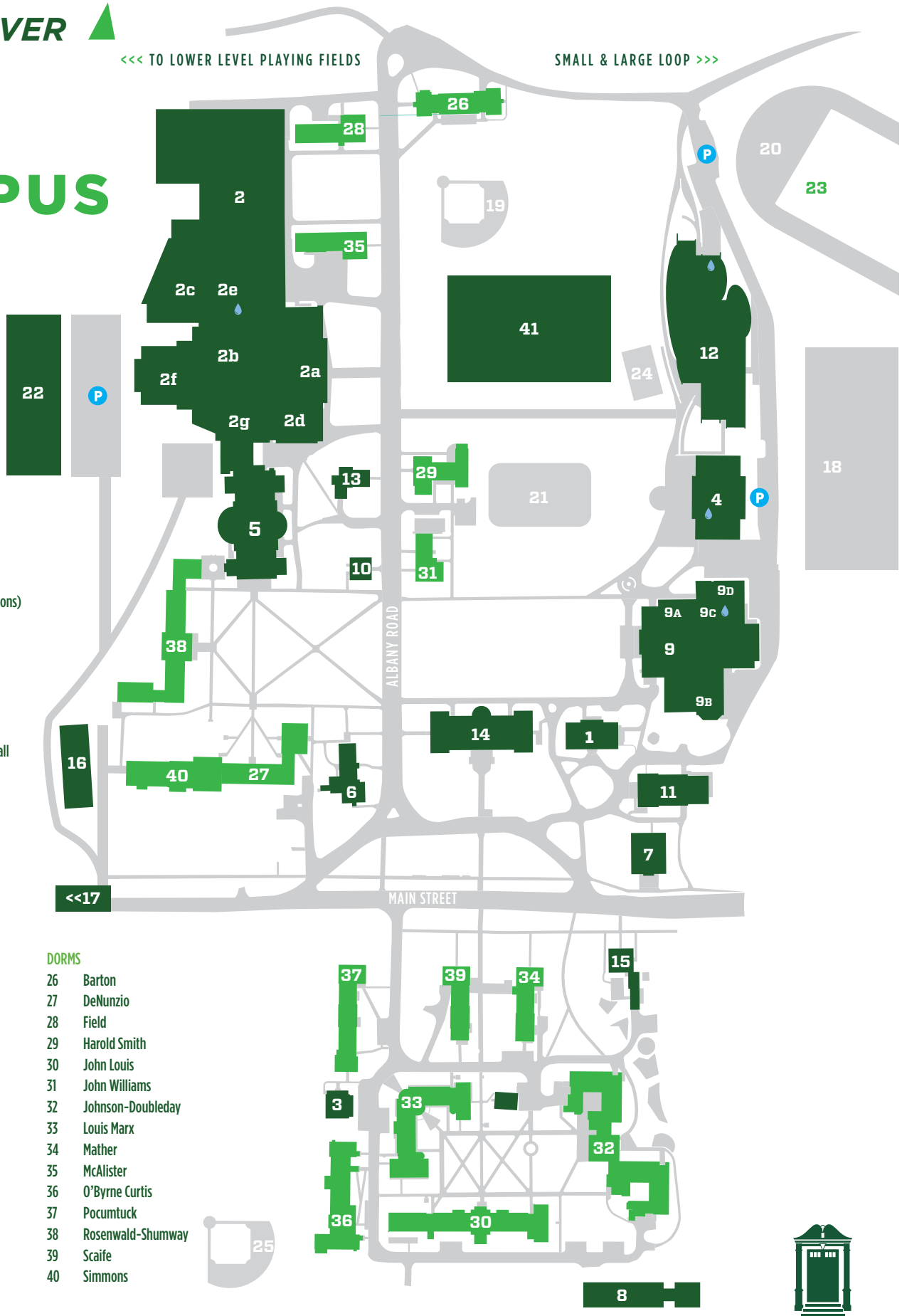

DEERFIELD ACADEMY LAPTOP PROGRAM

Congratulations on your acceptance to Deerfield Academy! As a Deerfield student, you will participate in our student laptop program. This means that a new Apple MacBook Air will be yours while you are a student here! Every student has a laptop, and every academic building, student room, and most public spaces provide high-speed wireless service.

Your laptop will include our standard software applications including access to the latest version of Microsoft 365 apps, antivirus software, and access to several discipline-specific applications. The laptop will be protected with a four-year warranty as well as an insurance policy against theft and accidental damage. It can be brought to the ITS Help Desk at any time for refreshing or repair and loaner laptops are available while your computer is in the shop.
