The Last Two Weeks of the Term Overview

We do not have exam week schedules, though classes may have a final assessment or a major piece of work (project, paper, culminating assignment) due during the last two weeks of the term. Students should receive a schedule on Canvas from each of their teachers by **May 5** that clearly outlines the work due and/or assessments given during the last two weeks of the term.

Faculty Advisor & Advisee Planning Meetings

You should have a meeting with your faculty advisor as soon as possible after May 5 to review your schedule and help you plan for the end of the term. There is time set aside in the schedule for this during advisory meeting time (10:05-10:50am) on Friday, May 8 and Friday, May 15.

Requests to Move Assessments/Major Work

As is the case at any point of the school year, if students have more than two major pieces of work or assessments due on the same day, students may request to move one to an alternate date; students should communicate directly with the teacher whose major piece of work/assessment they wish to move. Teachers are expected to accommodate such requests as best they can. This may be best accomplished by completing the work earlier, especially going into the summer. Dean of Studies [Ms. Hemphill](#) should be consulted if difficulties arise.

Testing Study Hall During the Last Two Weeks of the Term

We will have normal Spring Term Testing Study Hall hours during the last two weeks of the term, and we will offer an additional evening during the last week of the term.

Testing Study Hall Hours

- Week of May 10: Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday evenings, from 7:45-9:30pm
- Week of May 17: Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday evenings, from 7:45-9:30pm

Testing Study Hall is held in Library 104 and begins promptly at the time listed and is capped at 10 students a session (first come, first served).

Deadline for Spring Term Academic Work

9th, 10th, & 11th graders: Must complete and submit their academic work for each of their courses by the end of the last day of classes (**Friday, May 22**), unless the student has an incomplete grade approved by [Ms. Hemphill](#) in the Academic Affairs Office.

Seniors & PGs: All academic work for the year—outstanding work, exams, papers or presentations, in whatever form—must be completed and/or submitted by the end of classes on **Wednesday, May 20**.

Reminders about Academic Integrity & Use of Artificial Intelligence

As a reminder, students are prohibited from using artificial intelligence (AI)-generative tools for student work (including AI editing services) unless under direct instruction from faculty to do so. If a teacher explicitly allows students to use AI, students must cite this and include all prompts they used in their process or submitted product.

Expectations for the Last Two Weeks of the Term

All teachers and students must adhere to the published Class Schedule during the last two weeks of the term (teachers may not cancel class and students may not depart campus early).

- Please note the Special Schedules on Wednesday, May 20, and Friday, May 22.
- Thursday, May 21 is “Senior Day,” and seniors do not attend classes. It is a normal class day for 9th, 10th, and 11th graders.

Cocurriculars & Athletics during the Last Two Weeks of the Term

- Week of May 11: Normal week of cocurriculars. Rec sports go through Friday, May 15.
- Week of May 18: No cocurriculars except for the rowing and golf teams.
